- **Old Complaints—Key Ct. Mobile home park, lot 9-blight. No demo started. Owner of park sent letter to court requesting 30 days longer, after I had refused the request. A copy of the letter was sent to the twp. attorney. Per twp. Attorney office, the judgement stands as is. No motion was made by defendant for extension, i.e the letter means nothing as far as the case is concerned. The court order granting the township to demo the bldg. was signed on December 15<sup>th</sup> by Judge Farrell. It gave owner 90 days to have the building demolished. 90 days were up on March 15, 20126.**

After waiting a couple of hours to get some clarification from FLTF Larry expressed concern that residents should be notified by Nixle or other communications if there might be any danger to residents. Discussion followed.**
- **Supervisor Comments—Supervisor Doyle commented on the Key Court Mobile Home Park and the trailer that needs to be removed. Has received a quote for \$8700 to remove it completely. Will request bids from other local contractors before committing.**
