- Fireboard Report—Timothy Saleski reported there were twenty-two runs in the county-with one run in Hay Township for a downed power line. There were thirtythree runs for the year in Hay. The Gladwin Fire Department is researching a millage increase to pay off the last fire truck purchased and to purchase another. Nothing solid in the works yet.

The Smallwood Lake Association would like to use the building for their May 24<sup>th</sup> meeting. Supervisor Doyle has also talked with Secord & Billings Townships about a possible merger with their fire departments in the future as they have medical and both Secord & Billings touch borders with Hay Township.
