The Hay Township Board met on Thursday, April 16, 2026, in regular session. Supervisor Doyle called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

**Commissioner's Report—**Commissioner O'Donnell spoke about it being Child Abuse Month. Our county jail is housing Ogemaw inmates and needs new cameras estimated to cost \$12,000. Tammy mentioned our road patrol has added two new deputies. The Gladwin County Road Commission has twenty-one projects scheduled. Sage Twp will be having a solar meeting on April 30<sup>th</sup>. The next Council of Local Government will be June 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Secord Twp. Hall at 6 p.m. O'Donnell mentioned the flyer sent by FLTF about preserving our natural shorelines.
