

**HAY TOWNSHIP**  
**Unapproved Minutes of June 8, 2017**

The Hay Township Board met on Thursday, June 8, 2017 in regular session. Supervisor Thomas Olson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call: Monaghan present, Priemer present, Olson present, Kludt present, Mudge present.

Commissioner's Report—Commissioner Smith could not be present but supplied the board with the Gladwin County District Library Circulation Report. Sharron also informed us by e-mail that the court house would be closed on June 15<sup>th</sup>. Consumers will be shutting off the power to change the phone systems. Rick Gent is currently working on the air conditioner. Parts are ordered. It is suggested the staff bring a fan in case it gets too warm in their offices.

Guests: 12

Lyric Raub spoke on recycling in Gladwin County. Ms. Raub would like to get suggestions on how to get recycling here. Lyric did some research and spoke of the benefits of recycling. Discussion followed.

1<sup>st</sup> Public Comments:

Wanda Raymer commented that Buckeye Township no longer has a recycling dumpster at their hall. Buckeye now has individual containers at their homes. Discussion followed.

Ms. Spratt inquired about mosquito abatement for Hay Twp. Both Trustee Monaghan and Supervisor Olson stated that there wasn't enough interest in the past and the cost would exceed the benefits because of all the state land. Discussion followed.

Approval of Minutes:

Minutes of May 11, 2017 were reviewed. Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Treasurer Kludt to accept minutes as written. M/C.

Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer's Report was given by Treasurer Kludt for May. Motion by Trustee Mudge, support by Supervisor Olson to accept Treasurer's report. M/C.

Warrants/Payments:

Monthly Warrants were reviewed. Motion by Treasurer Kludt, support by Supervisor Olson to pay monthly warrants. M/C.

- Communications—Letter from Michael Griffin on desire to start a special assessment district for 1 mile of Wieman Rd. with no cost to the township.
- Fireboard Report—Ray Peck reported there were 13 board members present and the warrants were approved. Truck #8 needed repairs and Ron Brabon of GCRC gave a report on Wildwood Bridge. It has gone over budget but should be completed before the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Fire training was discussed and there were 2 fire runs in Hay Twp. Wanda Raymer also stated her desire to attend other township meetings to discuss the Friends of Gladwin Firefighters.
- Ordinance Report—Dave Kelly stated there were no new complaints. Citations have been issued to resident on Andy's Lane and also the one at corner of M-30 and Highwood. Notice has been sent to owner at the M-30/Highwood complaint. One

location has been cleaned up and another nearly cleaned up on S. Whitney Beach. One complaint on Hay Rd. has been cleaned up with another on S. Hay Road requesting additional time. Have not heard from owners of the Maple Point and Wieman Rd. junk complaints. Reissued a 30-day notice on Lockwood junk complaint and owner at @ Whitney junk complaint is putting up fence. Burned shed on M-30 S. of M-61 still waiting on. Wanda Raymer gave info to Dave on other property with problems.

- **Liquor Inspection Report:** Dave Kelly said everything looks fine at both locations.
- **Unfinished Business—Well & Septic.** Trustee Mudge spoke on information he gathered on regulations concerning well & septic. Information included a chart on how frequently to have septic pumped according to size of house and occupants present. Trustee Mudge also spoke of the study on the blue/green algae and the toxins it creates. We will be putting well & septic ordinance on hold until Representative Jason Wentworth speaks at the July board meeting. Jason will be presenting information concerning the state's bill that is being worked on by Representative James Louer and the Realtor's Association.
- **New Business—Birna Trail Maintenance Assessment Resolution #5.** Motion by Clerk Priemer, support by Trustee Monaghan to approve assessment resolution for Birna Trail Maintenance. Roll Call Vote: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays. M/C.  
**Waste Management Assessment Resolution #6.** Motion by Clerk Priemer, support by Supervisor Olson to approve assessment resolution for Waste Management. Roll Call Vote: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays. M/C.  
**Principles of Governance Pledge.** Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Treasurer Kludt to adopt township Principles of Governance set for by the MTA. M/C.  
**Hall Supplies Budget Amendment.** Motion by Trustee Mudge, support by Trustee Monaghan to increase Hall Supplies Budget by \$150.00. M/C.  
**Estimate for sliding glass window.** Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Trustee Mudge to install sliding glass window in Supervisor's office at the cost of \$250. M/C.
- **Public Comments:**
  - Wanda Raymer requested list of payments for the last couple of years to Aquatic Nuisance so she can make comparisons.
  - Ms. Sprott offered to help us set up e-fax at out township.
