The Hay Township Board met on Thursday, March 10, 2016 in regular session. Supervisor Thomas Olson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

- Commissioner's Report—Gladwin County Commissioner, Sharron Smith reported Headlee did not pass and changes will be made. Gladwin Nursing and Rehab on Pratt Lake Rd. is remodeling and 211 reports that they are in need of housing. Library report was given and a proposed 5 year Gladwin County Recreation Plan was approved. Larry Grell of Billings offered challenge to all county and township boards to collect donations to keep Gladwin County Historical Building operating. Flood at courthouse still creating problems for county. Saturday, March 19 there will be a performance at BAC by the Saline Fiddlers from Saline High School. Also on Saturday, April 23, there will be a performance of past stars of BHS Forensics teams and begins at 6 p.m. Tomorrow will be a Legislative Breakfast at K of C Hall @ 7 a.m.
- Fireboard Report—Ray Peck reported Mayor Winarski is running for the 997<sup>th</sup> Representative seat that is open. Fire department will no longer receive phone bill from Verizon and Chief's calls will now come on separate itemized bill to manage account. There were 18 runs in February with 2 in Hay Twp.
- Constable Report—Ralph Vanderbush reported that everything looked good in township and there are new owners at the Wooden Shoe Bar.
- Ordinance Report—None.
- Unfinished Business—2016-2017 Budget was approved. Also saved approx. \$150 a month on phone and internet by switching to Charter.
