Unapproved Minutes of October 12, 2017

The Hay Township Board met on Thursday, October 12, 2017 in regular session. Supervisor Thomas Olson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call: Monaghan present, Priemer present, Olson present, Kludt present, Mudge present.

Commissioner's Report—Commissioner Smith was not able to attend but supplied her report. Sharron informed us that the county is working on a letter to Attorney General, Bill Schuette, requesting he remove the Drain Commissioner from his elected office. Commissioner Smith stated the road commission ride around was most interesting. The Gladwin County Chamber of Commerce will be hosting Meet the Candidates night Tuesday, Oct. 17 at the Gladwin City Park Community Building from 6:30 to 9:00 p.m. The General Fund balance was \$885,936.31 at the last board meeting. The county commissioners approved a request from Isabella County to approve that county implementing Septic Tank inspection at point of sale housing sales. Gladwin County will also make this request to change our zoning ordinances to require the same point of sale for housing sales in Gladwin County. Sharron notes they are currently searching for an attorney to represent the county in civil matters. Sharron supplied the stats for the Gladwin County District Library and congratulated the Beaverton football teams.

James Maveal, Animal Control Officer explained the .2 millage request for the Gladwin Animal Shelter that will be on the Nov. 7 ballot. Discussion followed.

Tom Smith, Auditor for Hay Township, discussed parts of the audit with the Hay Twp. Board members. Said we were doing an excellent job. Discussion followed.

- Fireboard Report—Ray Peck reported that Ron Brabon reported on Ride Around. Ron also stated that Black Creek would not be getting a culvert put in. Instead it will be blocked off. Ray Peck spoke of the improvements to the fire hall that needed to be made and the need of 8 tires to be replaced. Ray mentioned the MTA Fire Book that

covered required training levels for firefighters. Discussion. There were 17 fire runs in September, with 1 in Hay Twp. Wanda Raymer gave an update on the Open House that took place the last Saturday in September. Friends of Gladwin Firefighters raised nearly \$600 and there was entertainment for children and adults. Wanda also mentioned that the Friends of Gladwin Firefighters may replace the large flag with a new one.

- **Ordinance Report—** Dave stated there were a couple of places he needed to recheck. New complaint was God's House Mission. Dave sent a letter to the owner. Complaint on 2075 S. Whitney was unfounded. The blighted garage at 297 Oak has been repaired. Complaint at 1035 Maple may be a possible health violation-pends contact with residents.
