The fire department does have farm training. Approved EMS lease for another 4 years.**

The owner has contacted an environmental company and hired them to remove asbestos. He will tear down south end of bldg. after that is done. 300 Hickory—junk. Much improved. Contacted today and stated he should be able to get things done by the end of December. I mentioned a citation is a possibility. Lot 9, 221 Lakeview—blight. Double wide in Key Ct. Mobile home park. No owner info was obtained from the state of Michigan. Mgr. of park was contemplating demo or rehab. As of today, she has found an individual that is going to fix the double wide and**

move in when done. According to mgr. the cleanup process has begun. Pends completion.
