Motion by Trustee Mudge, support by Clerk Priemer to adopt the new ballot language for gravel road millage to read as follows: Shall the Township of Hay, Gladwin County, Michigan, impose an increase of up to 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for five (5) years, 2020 through 2024 tax billing inclusive, for the purpose of improving, maintaining, and repairing gravel roads in Hay Township, raising an estimated \$51,799 in 2020?
