

**HAY TOWNSHIP**  
**Unapproved Minutes of May 10, 2018**

The Hay Township Board met on Thursday, May 10, 2018 in regular session. Supervisor Thomas Olson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call: Monaghan present, Priemer present, Olson present, Kludt present, Mudge present.

**Commissioner's Report**—Commissioner Smith reported the Animal Shelter Committee held its first meeting and will be meeting the 4<sup>th</sup> Friday of each month. General Fund balance is \$225,593.56 before bills. Council of Aging will be asking for millage renewal plus small increase at August primary. Commission Board approved resolution asking governor to remove Bob Evans from his position as Drain Commissioner. Obsolete maps store in equalization department have been loaned to Gladwin County District Library and be available in the genealogy department. MSU presented their yearly report and are asking for renewal of its millage at August primary. Kim Krenz from DNR presented soil erosion and sediment control proposed ordinance. 2018 gypsy spraying will be limited to Grout and Sherman townships. The board approved the Gladwin County Zoning Ordinance test amendment dealing with marijuana growth and processing. Copies are on file at the twp. hall. DATA committee is working on possibly leasing computers and planning to replace phones. Sharron stated she will not be present at June meeting as she will be attending the national matches. Friends of the Library will hold their spring book sale May 17-19. Sharron also supplied the library stats and genealogy room report. Richard Gaft inquired about the road commission working on the drains. Says Oren Ct. looks terrible. Sharron recommended contacting GCRC, specifically Ron Brabon. Discussion followed. Also discussion concerning closing of Heil by DEQ. Supervisor Olson explained reasons behind the closing. Wanda Raymer informed Richard Gaft that maps were available at road commission.

**1<sup>st</sup> Public Comments:** Robert Watton inquired about Heil Rd. Supervisor Olson said DEQ shut it down because they want the water to free flow. Mr. Watton stated shutting Heil Rd. down keeps people from accessing state land. George Benson stated the DNR are closing people out. Discussion. Mr. Watton believes township can take position on ATV usage on sides of road such as M-30 and M-61. Discussion followed. Wanda Raymer stated park in Hay Twp. was now state owned.

**Approval of Minutes:**

Minutes of April 12, 2018 were reviewed. Motion by Treasurer Kludt, support by Trustee Mudge to accept minutes as written. M/C.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Treasurer's Report was given by Treasurer Kludt for April. Motion by Supervisor Olson, support by Clerk Priemer to accept Treasurer's report. M/C.

## **Warrants/Payments:**

**Monthly Warrants were reviewed. Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Supervisor Olson to pay monthly warrants. M/C.**

- **Communications—National Flood Insurance Program mandatory requirements letter. Supervisor Olson spoke on the program and the mandated requirements. Trustee Mudge inquired if we needed to okay the requirements, but it was determined we needed more information before proceeding. Supervisor Olson will do follow up on issue. Discussion.**
- **Fireboard Report—Ray Peck gave the fire report. Helen Gary gave blessing of badges. Wanda Raymer gave update on Friends of Gladwin County Firefighters activities. Will be working on green address signs. The Fire Chief gave update on the building project and there will be open bids on May 11 @ 5:30 to open bids. A special meeting on May 14 @ 6:30 to award project bid. Several board members will be taking fire training course and the new flag has been put up. There were 2 fire runs in the township. Body recovery on E. Sun Oil Rd. and an EMS assist on Andy's Lane.**
- **Ordinance Report— Dave stated there was no new junk/blight complaints. Complaint on S. Whitney Beach Rd. was supposed to put up fence but property looks worse now than before. Property at M-30 and Highwood is looking better. During discussion, a new complaint was placed on the old Winegars school property.**
- **Liquor Inspection Report: Dave Kelly reported there were no violations and both establishments checked out fine.**
- **Old Business—NIMS compliance; Trustee Monaghan and Supervisor Olson has one more test to take.**

**Special Assessment Rules; Printed copies of rules and forms were given to board members to read so we could better understand procedures. Will discuss at next board meeting in June.**

**Tornado Siren; Emergency Management Director wanted to place siren at corner of M-30 and Highwood Rd. Discussion. Board would like siren placed in more populated area such as Wooden Shoe/White Star area to benefit more people.**

- **New Business—Mobile Folding Chair Cart; Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Trustee Mudge to purchase mobile folding chair cart. M/C.**

**Yard Waste Pick Up; Pick up by Waste Management for yard waste will be on Wednesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>. Guidelines are available at the twp. hall.**

**Smallwood Lake Association Meeting; Meeting will be held at the Hay Twp. Hall on May 26, 9-1 p.m.**

**Boyce Hydro Property Split; Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Clerk Priemer to split Boyce Hydro Property #110-015-300-001-06 contingent upon receiving**

payment. M/C.

**Election Meals; Discussion. Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Supervisor Olson to approve township to pay for meals at cost of \$8 per meal (lunch & dinner) per person. M/C.**

**Election Pay; Discussion. Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Supervisor Olson to increase election pay from \$11.25 per hour for Chair to \$12.25 per hour and from \$10.25 per hour for Election Inspectors to \$11.25 per hour. M/C.**

**Power Wash Building/Wash Windows; Discussion. Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Clerk Priemer to have building power washed and windows washed at cost of \$500 or less. M/C.**

**Budget Amendment to 101-265-932 Building Maintenance & Repair; Motion by Clerk Priemer, support by Treasurer Kludt to approve budget amendment of \$900 increase to Building Maintenance & Repair account #101-265-932 to cover cost of carpet cleaning, outside building cleaning and outdoor bulletin board. M/C.**

**Local Assessing Reform; Discussion led by Assessor Corey Cuddie concerning the possibility of increased training for assessor and B.O.R. State is looking for feedback from the townships. Will proceed when more information is obtained.**

**GCRC Gravel Project; Motion by Supervisor Olson, support by Treasurer Kludt to approve GCRC graveling on Trunk line Maintenance Work. M/C.**

- **Public Comments: Vince Torres inquired of possibility of Hay Twp. allowing marihuana growers in our ordinance. Discussion. Vince was informed that township was not considering growers at this time.  
Robert Watton inquired as to Boyce Hydro's plans. Was informed the boat ramp was for Boyce Hydro's use to repair spillways.  
Wanda Raymer informed audience that the address signs would be sold for \$12 per side and \$16 for both sides.  
Supervisor Olson informed everyone of the work to be done on Highwood Bridge and that the bridge would be shut down from Sept. 1 to Nov. 1. Supervisor Olson also said he would get Deer Rd. signs placed at appropriate intersections.  
Trustee Mudge thanked guests for coming and for the telling of some of the earlier history of the area of Wooden Shoe and White Star. Trustee Mudge also spoke of the study that is being conducted by the 3 associations to determine what could happen by obtaining the rights to the dams. Discussion followed.**
