- Fireboard Report—Tim Saleski—There were 14 runs with 1 rubbish fire in Hay Township. Gladwin County Fire Department has a 5-year plan to tear out the asphalt surrounding the fire station. Estimated cost at over \$100,000. Will get bids.
- Ordinance Report—Old Complaints—2025 S. M-30—Blight—Much better. Complaint closed. 1354 Highwood Rd.—Junk. Still numerous junk vehicles on property. Gave the owner until July 15th to get rid of them. 2136-2150 S. Whitney Beach—Junk. Left a phone message for owner-no response and no action. Issued citation for violation of the twp. Junk ordinance. Upon checking properties today, found most are much better. A small truck is on a trailer. However, the small truck, boat and utility trailer are still there-pends contact with court and possible additional citations. 2206 S. Whitney Beach—Junk. Very much improved. Junk vehicles are gone. Still some "stuff" but the lot is very small.
- New Complaints—1651 S. M-30—Blight and junk. Wood business. S portion of building has burnt. Misc. junk scattered about. Pends contact with owner.
