Unapproved Minutes of August 15, 2024

The Hay Township Board met on Thursday, August 15, 2024, in regular session. Supervisor Mudge called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Commissioner's Report: Commissioner O'Donnell reported that the Household Hazardous Waste had a record turnout with fourteen from Hay Township. The Council of Local Government will meet on Aug. 26 at 7 p.m. at Secord Township. Tammy is still working on the recycling 3-year plan that will be required to be in place by 2027. Requirements from the State of Michigan will be either a drop off container at the township or curbside pickup for recycling materials. Commissioner O'Donnell is also working on a committee for regulation of short-term rentals.
