

HAY TOWNSHIP
Unapproved Minutes of September 8, 2016

The Hay Township Board met on Thursday, September 8, 2016 in regular session. Supervisor Thomas Olson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call: Monaghan present, Priemer present, Olson present, Kludt present, Mudge present.

Approval of Minutes:

Minutes of August 11, 2016 were reviewed. Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Treasurer Kludt to accept minutes as written. M/C.

Guests: 13; Laura Brandon-Maveal, Gladwin County Clerk presented the Election Report Card to the township. Laura said she was impressed with our election inspectors, Twp. Clerk Priemer and presented twp. with a perfect report card.

Tom Smith, Hay Twp. Auditor—Tom presented Hay Twp. with audit report card. Tom said we followed all the rules, our financial statements all look good and that we received an A on our report card. Tom commented Clerk Priemer did a good job. Trustee Mark Mudge asked for clarification on a few items. Discussion.

Ron Brabon, GCRC—Ron reported they purchased a new dump truck at GCRC. Also that Stillwagon Rd. was finished and that Center Ave. in Secord Twp. was next. Ron commented that M-30 should have 1 lane open soon. Discussion followed. Ride Around will be on Sept. 21st for anyone who is interested.

Dave Pettersch, GCRC—Dave gave yearly report on where GCRC spent the money on roads. Said Hay Twp. was in good shape. There will be a dam engineer coming out to give recommendations on Black Creek Dam. Larry Thorington commented he was present when 1st dam was put in place. Discussion followed. Dave reported cost of \$1 million dollars to complete 2 miles of Wieman Rd. Dave presented Hay Twp. board with Paser Report and Wanda Raymer spoke of Lakeshore and Lakeview issues. Ray Peck asked about Highwood Bridge and Dave indicated there would be a review date on Oct. 5. Dave reported Wildwood needed a culvert replaced, and GCRC has new salt shed.

1st Public Comments: Wanda Raymer commented that someone wanted the downed wood on Lakeshore property owned by township. Twp. board said it was fine as long as they did not take down any trees. Wanda also commented on street light on Lakeshore never shutting off.

Treasurer's Report was given by Treasurer Kludt for August. Motion by Clerk Priemer, support by Supervisor Olson to accept Treasurer's report. M/C.

Warrants/Payments:

Monthly Warrants were reviewed. Motion by Trustee Monaghan, support by Supervisor Olson to pay monthly warrants. M/C.

- Commissioner's Report—Gladwin County Commissioner Sharron Smith was not present but supplied report to twp. Sharron reported the county board was gathering proposed budget from each department and the work on the entrance is at a standstill. County's new website will be launched after the Wed. DATA meeting. More info to come next month. Sharron congratulated current Treasurer and Clerk on

being elected to the respective boards of their statewide associations. The county board met with 2 commissioners of Clare County Board to work out an agreement concerning joint payment of shared courts. The recount for Drain Commissioner was held 9-6-16. The new Dollar General is opening soon in Albright Shores. The GCRC Ride Around is on Sept. 21 at 8 a.m. Sharron also sent along the Gladwin County District Library circulation report.

- **Fireboard Report**—Ray Peck reported Christ the King Church will hold memorial on Sept. 11 at 5 p.m. On Sept. 24th, the Fire Dept. will hold their yearly Open House 11-2 p.m. Ray stated door at fire house was finished and that there were 23 fire runs in August. Wanda Raymer stated the Friends of the Gladwin Fire Fighters were holding a bake sale for the Open House on the 24th. Also on the 24th, there will be a thank you from Emergency Mgt.
- **Constable Report**—Ralph Vanderbush—Ralph thanked everyone for participating in his wife Carol’s memorial and for keeping Ralph in their prayers. Ralph stated everything was going well in the twp. and that the River House Bar in Wooden Shoe was looking good.
- **Ordinance Report**—Dave Kelly reported new complaint on Radov Drive concerning long grass. Advised complainant there was no long grass ordinance. Complaint at 1500 block of N. Hay has been cleaned up. Complaint at 2200 block of S. Whitney Beach is improving. Owner put up fence and is continuing to clean up property. Repairs have begun at Elevation Drive’s blighted building. Andy’s Lane demolition is continuing. Property on Highwood and S. Whitney Beach Rd. was inspected again and insurance money will be released to owner next week. Highwood and M-30 is looking better. Supervisor Olson will do a drive by and give opinion.
